Dear ISVA Voluntary Service Scholarship Applicant:

The primary purpose of the Indian Springs Village Association is to promote the health, safety, common good and welfare of the residents of the Village and to aid, benefit and promote plans and recommendations relating to the physical, social or cultural development of The Woodlands. We are a voluntary, elected Board and one of our functions is to recognize and promote good citizenship and community service by awarding tuition scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each.

To be eligible for the ISVA Community Service Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Currently reside in the Village of Indian Springs
- Be a graduating high school senior or recent high school graduate (or home schooled)
- Plan to enter an institution of higher learning (2 or 4 year or vocational) in fall 2024 for the first time
- Truthfully complete and timely submit the attached application

The scholarships will be awarded primarily on community service and citizenship, so please provide very specific descriptions of your service to community. Other factors, including academics will be considered only secondarily. This scholarship honors those who have chosen to serve their community, though the type of service is not limited in any way. Please be expansive. Deferment of entrance into an institution of higher learning will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. Applicants may, however, reapply in a subsequent year.

There are several dates to keep in mind.

- 2024 graduates may submit complete applications at a time designated by their College Counselor on or before March 22, 2024 for ISVA pick-up at TWHS and TWCP schools on March 22, 2024.
- All other applicants must mail completed applications to: Indian Springs Village Association; ATTN: Scholarship Committee; P.O. Box 130291; Spring, TX 77393. Applications must be postmarked on or before March 22, 2024.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by email.
- Scholarship recipients and their guests will briefly attend an ISVA Board meeting (date TBD) to be recognized. Photos for publicity will be taken that evening as well.
- Recipients may also be recognized at TWHS or TWCP awards ceremonies in May 2024.
