Neighbors', Elected Officials and Candidates Comments:

Law Enforcement Report: Specialist Tavarez provided the law enforcement report for the month of September. Indian Springs Arrests: 2 DWI, no public intoxication, no narcotics, no criminal mischief, no burglary of a motor vehicle, no burglary of a building and no burglary of a home. There were 20 vehicle crashes this month across Indian Springs. Indian Springs had a total of 605 calls for service including 187 area patrols, 65 vacation watches, 25 welfare checks, 18 suspicious persons, 3 suspicious vehicles.

- MCSO reminded about the autism awareness program and the MCSO App.
- Halloween safety reminder to have kids stay with adults and that costumes are flame retardant, don't block vision and are not trip hazard.
- There is also a new program for missing children where fingerprints and all information for an amber alert are stored on a card.

Fire Chief Buck provided an update and fire prevention week – cooking fire safety starts with you. Largest cooking fire day is Thanksgiving. He reminded to always keep ovens closed with a fire and for grease fires on the stove use tight fitting lids, baking soda or fire extinguisher. Also reminded that outdoor fires need up to 3 days for the embers to go out completely.

Secretary's Report: Minutes from the August and September were distributed. To be approved next month as there was not a quorum.

Treasurer's Report: Tripp provided the treasurer's report. Increase for FY2024 to \$15,000 was approved by the township. Have received \$1050 in booth proceeds and need 6 more booths to meet the budget. There is no incentives this year for the 3R Bazaar and no flea market.
