Law Enforcement Report: Specialist Tavarez provided the law enforcement report for the month of September. Indian Springs had 3 DWI, no public intoxication, 1 narcotics arrest, 1 criminal mischief, no burglary of a motor vehicle, no burglary of a building and no home burglary. There were 17 vehicle crashes this month across Indians Springs.

MCSO is now producing a monthly PSA for safety.

Chief Buck – Fire Department Report

October is fire prevention month and fire prevention week is the week containing October 9. He spoke on the importance of working smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms. Change batteries on alarms at time change and fire alarms should be in all bedrooms and on all floors, and ideally also in attic. The Fire Department will come check after a lightning storm if the strike is close to the house.

Gordy Bunch and Jeff Jones Presentation

Provided the overview of the history of the Woodlands and triggers to review incorporation including roadways, flooding and COVID funding. If election is approved for incorporation would then start the process for creation of the home rule charter and election of mayor and city council. MUDs are not currently included in the incorporation plan. Tax rate on the ballot is \$.2231

Zipporah Singleton spoke regarding her campaign for township director position 7.

Treasurer's Report: Ken provided the monthly report prior to the meeting and the budget was approved. Michael and Ken are currently working through the State of Texas and IRS for resolution of the tax exempt status.
