**Call to Order:** MaryAnn Braid called the joint meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

**Neighbors', Elected Officials and Candidates Comments:**

**Law Enforcement Report:** Specialist Medina provided the law enforcement report for the month of January. Indian Springs had 2 DWI, no public intoxication, 2 narcotics arrest, 5 criminal mischief, 2 burglary of a motor vehicle, no burglary of a building and 1 home burglary. There were 21 vehicle crashes this month across Indians Springs. 480 calls for service, including 132 area patrols, 17 vacation watches, 134 traffic stops, 11 suspicious persons.

MCSO continues with the initiative for autism to mark vehicles and homes with stickers as March is Autism awareness month.

**Dr. Shelley Sekula-Gibbs** provided a report from the Township:

- Montgomery county Commissioner's Court announced that there would be an at grade improvement at Grogans Mill and Research Forest
- Express bus service to the Rodeo and permanent Express bus service to the Energy Corridor
- Continue to buy local or online as 46% of our budget is supported by sales tax

**Terri MacArthur from Environmental Services** provided an update on the campaign regrading dog poop, as everything that is left behind goes in the drainage channel to the nearest waterway. Villages can also add storm drain markers to remind neighbors to not put anything into the storm drain.

**Parks and Recreation "Road Show":** Angel Nicks and John McGowan spoke on the Parks and Recs Department, covering an overview of all 9 departments and their respective responsibilities and events; Parks and Rec has now opened 150 parks and average age of parks has now exceeded 20 years. Total Budget is \$25M and has been awarded a number of national awards.

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes from January were approved as submitted

**Treasurer's Report:** Tripp provided the financial report and the new 2022 budget with the revision of the format detailing amount of restricted v unrestricted funds; New fiscal year begins in April and will confirm donations to schools and other organizations at a later date. Received \$500 for the pollinators challenge.

**The Woodlands Township:** John Osborne distributed The Woodlands Township schedule of events and the Board of Directors Meetings

- Neighborhood Watch won first place in our population group for 2021 (in competition with Orlando, etc)
- Blood drive scheduled for Feb 10<sup>th</sup> at the Township building.
