**Call to Order:** Mary Ann Braid called the joint meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

**Neighbors', Elected Officials and Candidates Comments:**

**Fire Chief Buck** spoke as June is open house month at the village fire stations. He reminded everyone on heat safety and fireworks safety due to the ongoing drought.

**Law Enforcement Report:** Specialist Medina provided the law enforcement report for the month of May. Indian Springs had 3 DWI, no public intoxication, no narcotics arrest, 1 criminal mischief, 2 burglary of a motor vehicle, no burglary of a building and no home burglary. There were 21 vehicle crashes this month across Indians Springs. 516 calls for service, including 152 area patrols, 21 vacation watches, 131 traffic stops, 20 suspicious persons. MCSO warned about increased reports (not locally) of unlawful tracking using Airtags and similar devices.

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes from May were approved with the one change for the payment of 6 months of storage fees.

**Treasurer's Report:** Received \$300 for Woodlands Greenup. Township has removed funding from Woodlands Green for the Pollinator Challenge and 3R Bazaar and budget was adjusted accordingly. The Township has requested feedback on the 2023 budget and Tripp recommends a \$1500 increase in village allocation. The board approved the purchase of a chip reader for \$55.

**The Woodlands Township:** Erin Redmon distributed The Woodlands Township schedule of events and the Board of Directors Meetings and Emergency Preparedness packets.
